

Call for nominations for the position of VP Scientific Affairs

The Vice-President Scientific Affairs presides over the National Scientific Advisory Committee (NSAC) to build the scientific program of the national conference. NSAC also examines applications for ASM's visiting speaker program. This is an exciting role, which enables the development of initiatives to determine the direction of the national conference and build the scientific profile of the society. The position is for 3 years, but can be extended to 5 years. The successful nominee will serve one year as VP elect before taking up their role. During this period they will work with the current VP Scientific Affairs, Professor Dena Lyras, In addition to overseeing their specific portfolio area, the successful nominee will be a member of the executive team. In this role she or he will interact with the other VPs and the ASM President to guide all aspects of the society's operations.

We now call for nominations for the position of VP Scientific Affairs. Candidates for election to this shall be members of the ASM. They must be proposed and seconded by Society members and provide a short statement as to how their particular skills will contribute to the Society.
